CORONATION
DAY
JUNE 2ND, 1953

THE CORONATION AREA WITHIN THE CORONATION RING ROAD WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL GENERAL VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FROM MID-NIGHT ON CORONATION EVE, i.e., THE NIGHT OF JUNE 1/2. CARS BRINGING SPECTATORS, PROVIDED THEY BEAR THE OFFICIAL WINDSCREEN LABELS, WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE CORONATION AREA FROM 2.30 a.m. ON THE MORNING OF JUNE 2ND UNTIL THE PARKING ACCOMMODATION WITHIN THE AREA IS FULL. POINTS OF ENTRY TO THE PARKING PLACES WITHIN THE CORONATION AREA WILL BE SIGN-POSTED AND DRIVERS SHOULD

PROCEED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SIGN-POSTED DIRECTIONS OR THE INSTRUCTIONS OF THE POLICE.

RESIDENTS WITHIN THE CORONATION AREA SHOULD TAKE CARE TO HAVE THEIR CARS GARAGED ON THE NIGHT OF JUNE 1/2, AS ALL ROADS WITHIN THE AREA WILL BE CLEARED BY THE POLICE OF ALL CARS STANDING ON THE HIGHWAY. RESIDENTS WITHIN THE AREA WHO EXPECT TO USE THEIR CARS ON CORONATION DAY SHOULD APPLY TO THE POLICE FOR WINDSCREEN LABELS AS IN PARAGRAPH 1 BELOW.

1 Members intending to view the Coronation Procession from points along the route, and who intend to travel to the Coronation Area by car, should make written application in an envelope marked "Windscreen Labels" in the top left-hand corner, to the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis (Coronation Traffic Dept.), New Scotland Yard, S.W.1 for a coloured windscreen label. The application should state clearly the section of route that it is wished to reach, and a stamped addressed envelope measuring not less than 7 1/2" x 5" must be enclosed. No car without an official windscreen label will be permitted to enter the Coronation Area.

2 On reaching the Coronation Ring Road motorists will be directed by signs to the entry point for the area corresponding to the colour of their windscreen label and in turn to the parking streets allotted. On arrival at the latter, cars will be parked under Police instructions. Parking places may be at some distance from the Processional route. The possession of an official coloured windscreen label is no guarantee that parking will be available within the Coronation Area, as parking places will be filled in order of arrival.

3 Special arrangements are being made for cars conveying those holding tickets for seats in Westminster Abbey. Details will be made known through official sources to those concerned. This route will be specially sign-posted.

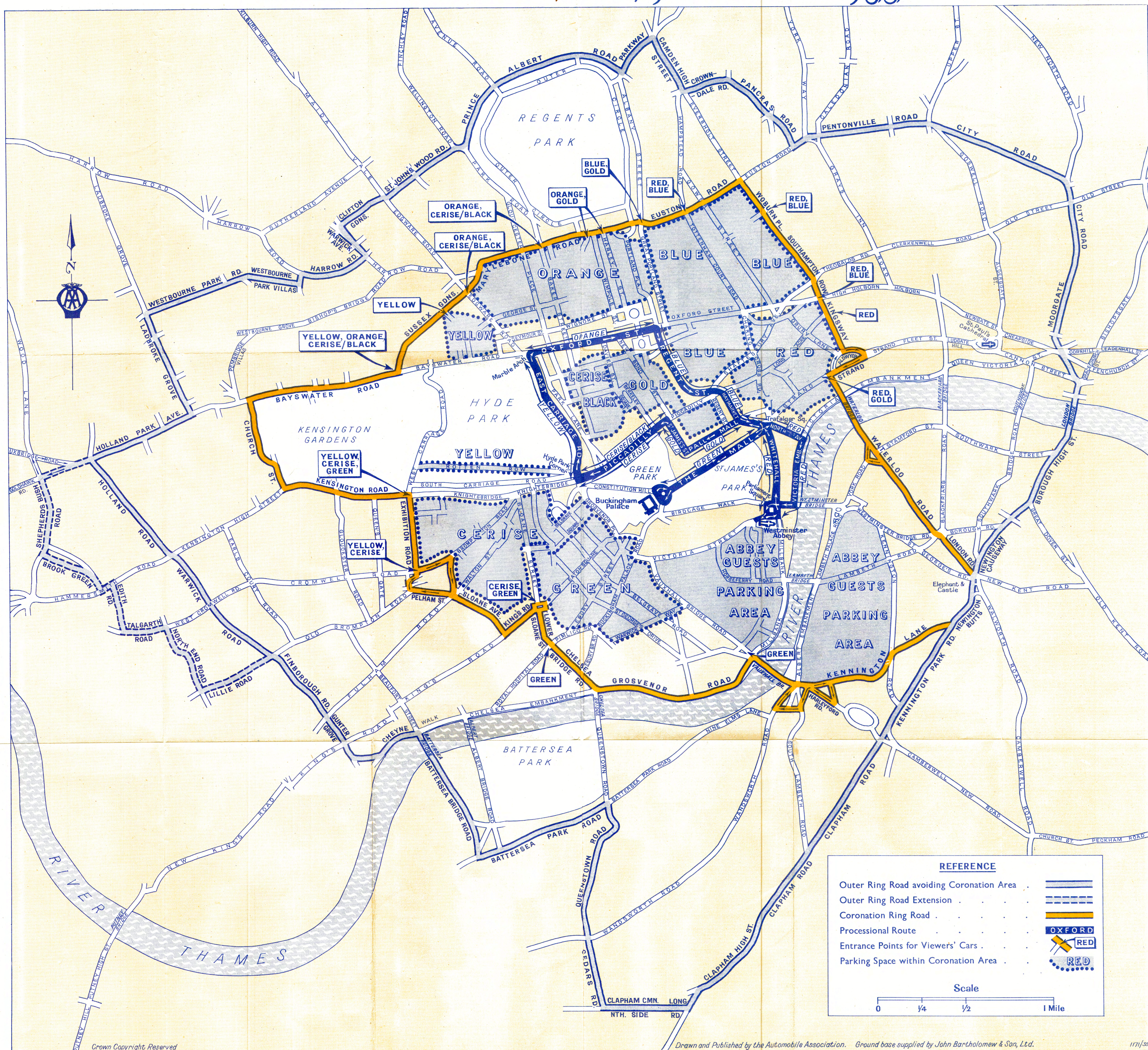
4 Spectators are strongly recommended to be in their places at the following times at the very latest:-
6 a.m. The Mall, Trafalgar Square, Northumberland Avenue, Victoria Embankment, Bridge Street, Parliament Square, Broad Sanctuary, Parliament Street, Whitehall and Cockspur Street.
7 a.m. Haymarket, Pall Mall, St James's Street, Piccadilly, and East Carriage Road, Hyde Park.
9 a.m. Marble Arch, Oxford Street, Oxford Circus, Regent Street and Piccadilly Circus.
N.B. The Victoria Embankment is being entirely reserved for school children in organised parties.

5 The sign-posted Outer Ring Road will be available for traffic wishing to avoid the Coronation Area completely.

6 During the times when troops from Olympia and Earl's Court are marching to the Coronation Area, the Outer Ring Road and the Coronation Ring Road will both be extended. These extensions will be brought into use at the discretion of the Police.

7 Dispersal. The times at which it will be possible for motorists to leave the Coronation Area after the Procession has passed will depend on circumstances. The dispersal arrangements will be under Police control, and motorists wishing to leave the area must proceed outwards to the Coronation Ring Road or Outer Ring Road and not attempt to cross the Coronation Area.

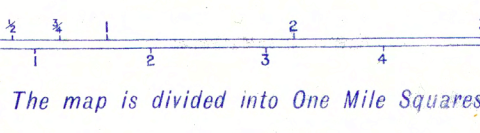
CORONATION DAY, JUNE 2ND 1953
